## A New Story From the Pen of Robert A. Lytle

Rochester's storyteller and author (not to mention, pharmacist!) has just released his latest book, *Bulwick School: A Yankee Lad in London*.

The story follows young Michael Hanlon, who, at age 14, loses both his parents in the 9/11 terrorist attacks. Michael opts to travel to England to live with his uncle, who operates a pub in a rundown section of London. At the pub, Michael is exposed to members of the IRA and begins to learn about their methods and beliefs, while at school he befriends a student whose father is part of the government's anti-terrorism efforts.

The story has to do with bullying in several of its many forms--from middle school playground skirmishes in suburban New York to centuries-old, religious battles in Ireland, and, most vividly, the horrific al-Qaeda attack on America on 9/11. It is actually a heart-warming story of two 14-year-old boys who come from opposite sides of the Anglo-Irish issue, how they become friends and resolve their age-old family differences.

Bob Lytle has been researching and writing this story for more than eight years, and bases his latest book in part on experiences he had while attending his fourth year of pharmacy school at Queen's University in Belfast, Northern Ireland.
